Subject matter for next years Scholarships. The following subjects were chosen:

Jr Division: What is peer pressure and can it be good? Explain.

The committee discussed if there was a need to raise the Scholarship money limits. The amounts for Seminar 34 were as followings:

Senior Division :	\$1,300.00

NCOAGA Memorial:	\$1,000.00
Junior Division:	\$600.00
MSgt Bennie S. Frick Memorial:	\$500.00

It was decided, after a short discussion, to leave the amounts as is.

A motion was presented to the committee to change the name of the NCOAGA Memorial Scholarship to include a deceased individual's name. After a brief discussion, it was decided that a motion to change the name would not be made. The scholarship, as named, is in honor of all deceased members of our association.

It was discussed that better communication is needed to get info out about our scholarships. Use e-mail as a source to spread the word. The scholarship program could also be used as a source to increase membership. The emphasis is mainly through our Regional Directors but it is still everyone's job to sell the scholarship program.
